It is also possible to prevent regrowth of algae thereafter by maintaining the pool with a suitable 7% copper algicide like POOL-PAL 100.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a solution of Federal Law to use this product in a manner consistent with its labeling.

For best results, brush down pool walls before the application, and again after the first and second day following application.

The product is concentrated. Using the information found below, calculate the required amount of this product to be applied to your pool. Then dilute the required amount of this product with at least 10 to 20 parts of water before application. To accomplish this, pour the required amount of this product into a plastic measuring can, fill with water, and operate the diluted product around the edge of the pool. For best results, the mixture should be distributed equally around the edge of the pool.

POOLS WITH VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH: Apply 4 oz of this product per 1,000 gallons of pool water.

POOLS WITHOUT VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH: Apply 2 oz of this product per 1,000 gallons of pool water every 5 to 7 days, or apply two weeks. Apply 1 oz of POOL-PAL 100 per 1,000 gallons of pool water.

NOTE: — Algae debris by swimming, if dead algae and other organic debris are present, before treatment, their removal by vacuuming is recommended before treatment. Skimmer prior to treatment and get it all done.

HOW TO ESTIMATE GALLON CAPACITY OF YOUR POOL
Formula: $LENGTH \times WIDTH \times DEPTH \times 7.5 = GALLONS$
For square or rectangular pools:
 $L \times W \times D \times 7.5 = GALLONS$
For circular or elliptical pools:
 $L \times W \times D \times 3.14 = GALLONS$
