2. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for the appropriate "Storage and Disposal" statements.
3. Delete the term "General Classification" from the labeling.
4. Delete the word "milk."
5. In the "Note to Physician" section, delete the following statement:

Measures against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Initial Application: To a cleaned pool, add 25.6 oz. to 50,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

Maintenance Dose: 6.4 oz. per 50,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain, add 6.4 oz. per 50,000 gallons of water as above.

Pour the required amount of this product into a plastic watering can, fill with water, and sprinkle the diluted product around the edge of the pool. For the best results, the mixture should be distributed equally around the edge of the pool with the filter running, and the pH and chlorine levels in the acceptable range.

Winter Directions: Apply 25.6 ounces to 50,000 gallons of water or ratio thereof monthly during the off-season or until water freezes if pool is located in a freezing climate. If pool cover is used, check under the cover periodically for visible signs of algae and reapply this product according to directions.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measure against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed.
