**Maintenance Dose:** 6.4 oz. per 50,000 (1.3 oz. per 10,000 gallons) of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

**Booster Dose:** Immediately after every rain, add 6.4 oz. per 50,000 gallons (1.3 oz. per 10,000 gallons) of water as above.

Pour the required amount of this product into a plastic watering can, fill with water, and sprinkle the diluted product around the edge of the pool. For the best results, the mixture should be distributed equally around the edge of the pool with the filter running, and the pH and chlorine levels in the acceptable range.

**Important:** Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**  
**FIRST AID**

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed.
