### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is used to control the growth of algae in exterior spas, whirlpools and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness spas, whirlpools or hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this product. Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs with just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 6 to 10 fluid ounces of this product per 500 gallons of water. To treat a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub add initially 3 to 7 fluid ounces of this product per 500 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 2.5 fluid ounces of this product should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools, spas, and decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
