This product is effective in controlling the growth of algae in swimming pools. The application of this product will control existing algae, and subsequent doses will control recontamination by algae. The treated water may be used immediately. NO WAIT TO SWIM.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To a freshly fill pool or at first visible signs of algae growth, pour the required amount of this product into a plastic watering can, fill with water, and sprinkle the diluted product around the edge of the pool. For best results, the mixture should be distributed equally around the edge of the pool.

DOSAGE RATES

VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH: Use 3.2 ozs. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

PREVENTION OF ALGAE: Use 1.6 ozs. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water once every two weeks.

BLACK ALGAE: To control Black Algae, use Poolcare Black Algaecide as directed on that product's label. Once control is obtained, resume regular PREVENTION OF ALGAE treatments with this product.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER
