PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Keep out of reach of children. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. On contact may cause eye or skin irritation. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid food contamination.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

STORAGE OR DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticide or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.

General Classification

Fabric treated as directed will develop residual bacteriostatic and self-sanitizing activity against odor-causing gram positive and gram negative micro-organisms, under conditions of high relative humidity or wet contamination. SANI-FLUFF inhibits the growth of ammonia producing organisms (*B. ammoniagenes*) that act on diapers, sheets and other articles of bedding and clothing, to produce ammonia.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SANI-FLUFF is designed for use in commercial laundries. Use 3 ounces of product per 100 pounds of dry laundry, by adding to the final rinse cycle at the low water level. Run for at least 5 minutes for maximum effectiveness.

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
DISPOSAL
