DIRECTIONS

To control root growth in sewer pipes use MARC 70 as follows:

Use MARC 70 twice yearly using one quart to each 75 to 100 feet of sewer. Apply in toilet nearest sewer line at night or during periods of low flow. Flush toilet after each quart of application. If sewer is completely blocked use mechanical or chemical methods to obtain some flow. Follow with repeat treatments until free flow is restored, then resume on semi-annual preventative treatment.

NOTE: Do not apply in sink or tub drains
