1. Replace the Precautionary Statements starting and ending with "Corrosive...eyes and clothing" with the following: "Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, skin or clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses), long sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, and chemical resistant gloves."
2. In the "Environmental Hazards" delete this section "This product may contaminate water through runoff. Poorly draining.....adjacent to treated areas".
3. In the section "Household Sewers", change the second to last sentence ("No more than two applications per calendar year") to "Do not make more than two applications per calendar year". After this revised sentence add a new sentence, "Do not use more than 1 gallon (4 quarts) of product in the same sewer line individual application.
4. In the "Storage and Disposal" section add the three missing subheadings "**Pesticide Storage**" (in front of "Store only...side walls"), "**Pesticide Disposal**" (followed by appropriate directions already on label), and "**Container Disposal**" (followed by the appropriate directions already on the label).
8. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this Notice or the next printing of the label, whichever occurs first, must bear the revised label.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

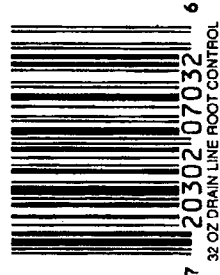
This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates and may contaminate water through runoff. This product has a potential for runoff for several months or more after application. Poorly draining soils and soils with shallow water tables are more prone to produce runoff that contains this product. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water except as specified on labeling, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash-waters or rinsate. This product may contaminate water through runoff. Poorly draining soils and soils with shallow water tables are more prone to produce runoff that contains this product. Certain water conditions including low pH (<6.5), low dissolved organic carbon (DOC) levels (3.0 mg/L or lower, and "soft" waters (i.e., alkalinity less than 50 mg/L), increases the potential acute toxicity to non-target aquatic organisms. Runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in waters adjacent to treated areas.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, either directly or through drift.

To control root growth in sewer pipes, use Drain Line Root Control as follows:

Household Sewers

Use Drain Line Root Control twice yearly at the rate of one quart to each 75 to 100 feet of sewer. Apply in toilet nearest sewer line at night or during periods of low flow. Flush toilet after each quart of application. If sewer is completely blocked, use mechanical or chemical methods to obtain some flow. Follow with repeat treatments until free flow is restored. Then resume semi-annual preventative treatments.

No more than two applications per calendar year. Not permitted in the State of Connecticut and California counties.

NOTE: Do not apply in sink or tub drains.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store only in tightly closed original container in a secure area inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its use. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls. Offer for recycling if available or discard in trash. Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

IF EMPTY: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash or offer for recycling if available.
