GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

DISINFECTION AND DEODORIZING: To disintect and deodorize hard non-porous surfaces such as bathroom tiles, fixtures, floors, chairs, shower stalls, walls, sinks and bathtubs, proceed as indicated below:

1. Hold container six to eight inches from surface to be treated, 2. Spray area until it is covered with the solution. Allow the product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes, 3.
