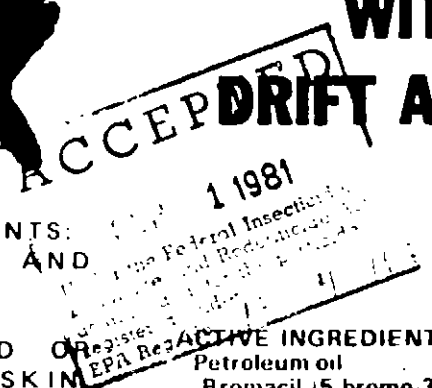




# VEG-A-KILL WITH DRIFT ARREST



### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**WARNING:**  
HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED OR  
ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN.

In case of contact, flush with large amounts  
of water. For eyes, get medical attention.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this  
product in a manner inconsistent with its  
labeling.

To control most weeds and grasses for  
extended periods on non-cropland areas such  
as industrial plant sites, parking lots, loading  
ramps and around storage buildings and the  
like apply 1 - 4 gallons per 1,000 square feet  
of MARC 26 VEG-A-KILL WITH DRIFT  
ARREST after the most predominant weeds  
have emerged. No agitation is required.  
MARC 26 VEG-A-KILL WITH DRIFT  
ARREST can be applied with standard spray  
equipment. For treating small areas, a tank  
type hand sprayer or sprinkling can may be  
used.

**NOTE:** Users should consult State Agricul-  
tural Experiment Stations or Extension Service  
Weed Specialists for recommendations as to  
use of MARC 26 VEG-A-KILL WITH DRIFT  
ARREST in their particular area, or write to  
Mid-American Research Chemical Corp.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not apply directly to, or  
otherwise permit MARC 26 VEG-A-KILL  
WITH DRIFT ARREST to contact desirable,  
woody or herbaceous plants or areas where  
their roots may extend. Avoid spray drift to  
such plants (coarse sprays are less likely to  
drift). Do not apply when weather conditions  
favor drift from areas treated. Thoroughly  
clean spray equipment with a suitable  
chemical cleaner before using for other  
purposes (or do not use the same equipment  
for other purposes).
