



VEG-A-KILL PLUS 2,4-D WITH DRIFT ARREST

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read and follow label directions to use this product properly. Do not use without labeling.

Use this product on weeds and grasses for extended periods on non-crop land areas such as industrial plants, parking lots, loading ramps, and around storage buildings, and the like. Apply 1-4 gallons per 1,000 square feet of MARC 60 VEG-A-KILL PLUS 2,4-D WITH DRIFT ARREST. Application requires MARC 60 VEG-A-KILL PLUS 2,4-D WITH DRIFT ARREST can be applied with standard spray equipment. For treating small areas, a tank type hand sprayer or backpack type sprayer.

IMPORTANT: Do not apply directly to, or otherwise permit MARC 60 VEG-A-KILL PLUS 2,4-D WITH DRIFT ARREST to contact susceptible plants as this product may injure cotton, beans, peas, grapes, flowers, fruit trees, ornamentals, or other desirable plants. Avoid spray drift to such susceptible plants as your sprays are less than 10 feet. Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not apply to areas overland by roots of desirable trees and shrubs. Thoroughly clean spray equipment with a suitable detergent cleaner before using for other purposes. Do not use same equipment for other
