(1) It is understood that you will submit and/or cite all data required for registration or re-registration of your product under Section 3(c)(5) of the FIFRA when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

(2) The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Registration No. 12204-18.

(3) Under "Disinfecting Industrial Areas" change (1 part to 32 parts water) to (1 part to 31 parts water).

(4) You will submit five copies of your finished printed labels as described in the A-79 enclosure. These labels must be submitted to the Agency before you release the product for shipment to comply with PR Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982. Refer to Section 162.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations for general requirements. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in rejection of your label.

A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records. Your release of the product for shipment constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with Section 6(e) of the FIFRA.
