

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

Do not get into eyes, on skin or on clothing. Causes severe skin irritation, especially to broken skin. Causes eye damage. Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles or faceshield and rubber gloves when handling this product. Remove and wash contaminated clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

SKIN & EYES: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician.
INGESTION: If swallowed drink egg whites, quinine solution or if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

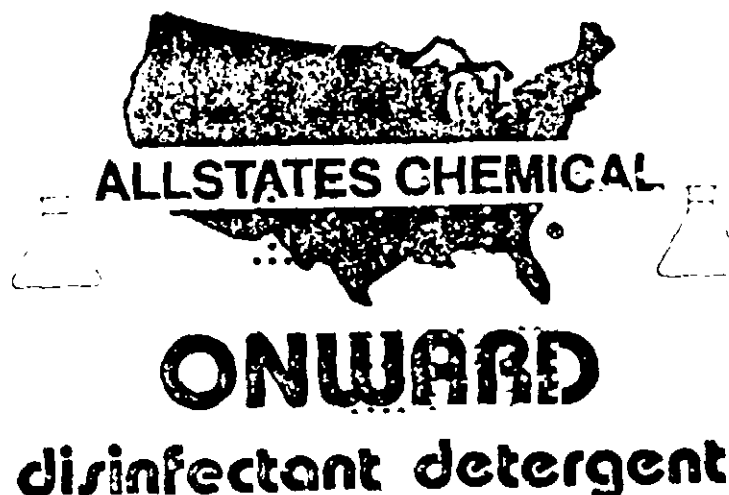
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide spray mixture or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill or bury in a safe place. A container size of 30 gallons or more may be reconditioned and offered for reconditioning.

STORAGE: Keep container closed and protect from freezing. If this product is stored in cold or freezing weather it may separate or thicken. This will not harm the performance. Before using allow to warm to room temperature and stir thoroughly.

FOR CLEANING

Lightly soiled areas: Surfaces to be cleaned may be pre-soaked with 1/2 cup of Onward per gallon of water. For heavily soiled areas, pre-soak with 1 cup of Onward per gallon of water. Rinse with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in hospitals, nursing homes and other public areas, mix 1/2 cup of Onward per gallon of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 1 cup of Onward per gallon of water before disinfecting.

To disinfect under rooms, stir white stain remover and 1/2 cup of Onward per gallon of water. Apply to floor and walls with a brush or sponge. Rinse with water. This solution will destroy Trichinella, hookworm, and other agents of dirt and odor.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION
