DIRECTIONS

To control most weeds for an extended
period of time on non cropland areas
apply Weed Killer as follows:

To control ANNUAL AND
PERENNIAL WEEDS AND GRASSES
use:

1 gallon per 700 to 5000 sq. ft.
To control Hard to Kill Perennial weeds
and grasses such as Johnsongrass,
Bermudagrass, Dallisgrass, Nutgrass,
Vasey grass, Saltgrass, Bouncing Bet,
Dogbane, Bracken fern, Horsetail use:

1 gallon per 300 to 1200 sq. ft.
The above dosage should be diluted
with sufficient water to cover the area
to be treated uniformly. Use the higher
dosage range on absorptive soils. Weed
killer may be applied with a fixed boom
power sprayer, hand tank-type sprayer,
or sprinkling can depending upon size
of area to be treated.

APPLY Mix 1 gallon Weed Killer with
10 gallons of water to puddle on area to
be treated.

IMPORTANT

Weed Killer is a concentrated weed
killer of the soil sterilant nature. DO
NOT apply, drain or flush equipment
on or near desirable trees, or other
plants or areas where their roots may
come in contact with the chemical. DO
NOT use on lawns and other similar
areas. Prevent spray drift to desirable
plants. DO NOT contaminate domestic
water. Keep from contact with
fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides, and
seeds. Clean equipment after use. DO
NOT use equipment for spraying

GENERAL INFORMATION

Weed Killer is a liquid concentrate
designed to be diluted with water and
applied as a spray on non-cropland
areas where bare ground is desired.
Weed Killer is an effective general
herbicide for the control of many
annual and perennial weeds and is
particularly useful for control of
perennial grasses.

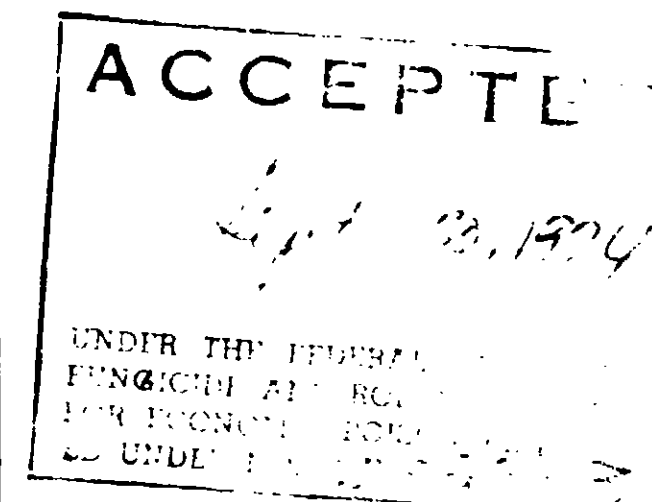
Effects are slow to appear and may not
become apparent until chemical has
been carried into the root zone of the
weeds by moisture. With this in mind,
during dry season it is suggested that
additional amounts of moisture be used
to carry the Weed Killer to the root
zone. The duration and degree of
control will vary with the amount of
chemical applied, soil type, rainfall,
and other conditions.

Weed Killer has been found to provide
effective control of such grasses and
weeds as: nutgrass, grass, wild oats,
crabgrass, ryegrass, bromegrass,
timothy, wild rye, quackgrass, purple
top, annual bluegrass, bluegrass, redtop,
perennial ryegrass, broomsedge,
aster, sanderson, pigweed, goldenrod,
plantain and wild carrot, johnsongrass,
bermudagrass, dallisgrass, nutgrass,
vaseygrass, saltgrass, bouncing bet,
dogbane, bracken fern and horsetail.
