1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. On the right panel under USE DIRECTIONS delete the term GENERAL DIRECTIONS.
 - b. On the right panel under USE DIRECTIONS add the following misuse statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."
 - c. On the front panel delete the term "Sanitizer."
 - d. On the left panel delete the entire second paragraph.
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

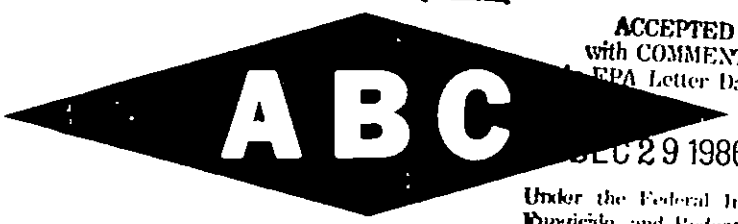
