DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with this labeling.

Feed Golden Sun Feeds Hi Phos "12" Larvi-Ban at the rate of one ounce per 750 pounds of body weight per head per day by mixing it into the ground grain or complete daily ration.

Start feeding Golden Sun Feeds Hi Phos "12" Larvi-Ban early in the spring before flies begin to appear and continue feeding throughout the summer into the fall until cold weather restricts fly activity.

Golden Sun Feeds Hi Phos "12" Larvi-Ban may be fed up to slaughter and to lactating dairy cows.

Golden Sun Hi Phos "12" Larvi-Ban prevents the development of horn flies, face flies, house flies and stable flies in the manure of treated cattle, but is not effective against existing adult flies. When starting a feeding program during the fly season, it is desirable to use other control measures to reduce the population of existing adult flies.

In some cases, supplemental fly control measures may be needed in and around cattle lots and buildings to control adult house flies and stable flies which can breed not only in cattle manure but in other decaying vegetable matter or sludge on the premises.

In order to achieve optimum fly control, Golden Sun Feeds Hi Phos "12" Larvi-Ban should be used in conjunction with other good management and sanitation practices.
