- 2. The new formulation and method of manufacturing proposed for this product are acceptable. The minor changes in nominal concentrations on the Confidential Statement of Formula dated June 10, 1992, are not likely to significantly affect bait performance.
- 3. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - The "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS" for mice should be changed to read

"MICE: Obtain 1-oz. bait pieces by breaking 4-oz. pieces of RODENT CAKE in half and breaking each half in half. Use one 1-oz. piece of RODENT CAKE per bait placement. Space placements at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Two 1-oz. pieces may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease."

4. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
