Each DITRAC Al-Weather CAKE consists of a one-pound sub scored to be broken into four 4-pz, pieces.

RATS: Break and apply 1 to 4 pieces of DiTRAC All-Weather CAKE (usually at intervals of 15 to 30 feet) per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh balt for at least 10 days or until signs of rat activity case.
