The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, subject to the following provisions:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Submit by April 27, 1993, results of a rat laboratory efficacy study (Protocol 1.213) conducted using weathered bait.
3. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - Under "SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:", delete "or mice" from the first sentence.
4. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

This registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e) if you do not comply with these conditions. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

## SEWER BLOCK

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**READ THIS LABEL:** Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hooved livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control of Norway rats in sewers. Also for control of Norway rats and Roof rats in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product is especially suited for wet or damp areas, such as river banks, gullies, irrigation ditches, sewers, garbage dumps and landfills.

Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:** Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by grouted openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternate food as possible.

### APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

**RATS:** Use one bait block per piece of wire to secure block above the high water at appropriate intervals—usually 15 to 20 feet. An uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 30 days is necessary for rat activity to cease.

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, replace bait stations and replenish as necessary.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. **STORAGE:** Store only in original container, tightly closed, out of reach of children and pets.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, in accordance with state and local authorities, by burning.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION
