### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**READ THIS LABEL:** Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are filled, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control of Norway rats in sewers. Also for control of Norway rats and Roof rats in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product is especially suited for wet or damp areas, such as river banks, gutters, irrigation ditches, basements, garbage dumps and landfills.

Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:** Determine areas where rats will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:**  
**RATS:** Use one bait block per placement. Secure bait block with wire to secure block above the high water mark. Replenish bait at appropriate intervals—usually 15 to 30 days. If an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for a rat activity cease.

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait with fresh bait. Dispose of all dead animals and leavings. If necessary, limit sources of rodent food as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, replace bait. Where a continuous source of infestation exists, replace bait in bait stations and replenish as necessary.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**  
Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. **STORAGE:** Store only in original container, tightly closed, out of reach of children and pets. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes and containers may be disposed of on site or at an approved facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Complete disposal of empty container in a sanitary landfill or by burning, as required by state and local authorities, by burning.
