

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Do not allow children in treated areas until surfaces are dry. Avoid contamination of food or food utensils. Avoid inhalation and skin contact.

Wash thoroughly after using and before smoking or eating. Do not use on household pets. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.
NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: If signs of cholinesterase inhibition are present, Atropine is antidotal and can be administered in conjunction with 2-PAM.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply to lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product kills bugs and insects listed below upon contact and provides residual control for up to two weeks. This product is designed for spot treatment only indoors, and for certain outdoor use. Do not use as a space spray. Spray until wet surfaces that are infested with crawling insects. Repeat as necessary for control.

HOUSEHOLD INSECTS: Cockroaches (Waterbugs), Ants, Silverfish, make spot applications of a coarse spray or apply with a paint brush to baseboards, areas around water pipes, cracks and crevices, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and similar areas where insects hide. Repeat application once a month.

CARPET BEETLES: Apply a spot application along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets, and on shelving, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected.

SPIDERS AND SCORPIONS: Spray around windows, doors and along baseboards. Make spot applications to other areas over which these pests may crawl.

PALENT PESTS: Expose stages (Sawtooth grain beetle, Flour beetle, Rice weevil, Cigarette beetle, Drugstore beetle, Indian meal moth). Spray shelves and cupboards where food containers suspected of infestation are stored. Remove all food and shelving paper before spraying. Do not replace food packages until spray has dried. Cover shelves with shelving paper. This treatment is supplemental to good housekeeping since it will have no effect on insects breeding inside of food packages. Infested packages should be destroyed.

BROWN DOG TICKS (FLEA BITES): Spray infested areas around the baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localized areas of floors and floor

coverings. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with this product.

NOTE: Do not use in the edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas where food is exposed.

USE IN OUTDOORS: To control insects such as Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Clover Mites, Fleas, Fleas, Fleas, Mosquitoes, Sowbugs, Springtails (Collembola) which are commonly found near the house and may enter the house, spray a 5 foot band of soil around the house as well as the base of the house to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Repeat application as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
