PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Any persons applying zinc phosphide products and experiencing signs and symptoms such as nausea, abdominal pain, tightness in the chest, or weakness should be seen by a physician immediately. If swallowed, drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or blunt object. Avoid use of all oils. Have patient lie down and keep warm. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention. If on skin or in eyes, flush with plenty of water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

RATS & MICE

Use Restrictions: Use against the Norway rat, roof rat and the house mouse, in and around homes, industrial, agricultural and commercial buildings, and similar man-made structures. ZP RODENT BAIT must be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals and wildlife or in tamper-resistant bait boxes. Do not place ZP RODENT BAIT in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

Selection of Treatment Areas: After removing as much food as possible, determine dry, accessible areas where rats and mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings,

in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rats and mice or their signs have been observed.

Application Directions for Norway Rat and Roof Rat: Apply 1 to 2 teaspoon amounts of ZP RODENT BAIT per placement. For outdoor use, place bait in active rat burrows or tamper resistant bait boxes. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until all signs of feeding have stopped. Do not treat the same area with ZP RODENT BAIT at less than 30 day intervals.

Application Directions for House Mouse: Apply 1 teaspoon amount of ZP RODENT BAIT per placement at 8 to 12 foot intervals. For outdoor use, protect bait from rain or snow. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until all signs of feeding have stopped. Do not treat the same area with ZP RODENT BAIT at less than 30-day intervals. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and excess bait properly.

GOPHERS

Use Restrictions: For use against pocket gophers in lawns, golf courses, and other noncrop areas. Do not apply in gardens and areas where food or feed may be contaminated. Only apply the bait underground. Collect and bury all dead animals found above the ground.

Application Directions For Pocket Gophers: Burrowing pocket gophers (Thomomys spp. and Geomys spp.) throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the fan and are jagged with soil. With a long-handled spoon carefully remove the plug, insert a teaspoon of ZP RODENT BAIT as far down as possible. Reclose opening, being careful not to cover bait with soil.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
