DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: After removing as much food, water and harborage as possible, determine dry, acid-free areas where rats and mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rats and mice or their signs have been observed.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS FOR NORWAY RAT AND ROOF RAT: Apply 1 to 2 teaspoon amounts of ZP RODENT BAIT per placement. For outdoor use, place bait in tamper-resistant bait stations. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until all signs of feeding have stopped. Do not treat the same area with ZP RODENT BAIT at less than 30 day intervals. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and excess bait properly.

POCKET GOPHERS

USE RESTRICTIONS: Use against pocket gophers in range crops, hay and alfalfa crops and vegetable crops. Lawns, parks, nurseries, lawns, golf courses, around homes, and other areas where gophers are a pest. Do not use in areas where the bait underground. Collect and bury all dead animals for disposal.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS FOR POCKET GOPHERS: Use the following methods for controlling pocket gophers.

PLUG REMOVAL BAITING: For owing pocket gophers (Dipodomys spp.) throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of the lateral tunnels coming to the surface on the flat side of the mound. With a long handled spoon carefully remove the plug. Insert ZP RODENT BAIT as far down as possible. Reclose opening, being careful not to drop suddenly and probe will fall about two inches into the tunnel.

MAIN RUNWAY BAITING: To locate main runways, probe mounds by use of an iron bar, a strong stick, or other suitable probe will drop suddenly and probe will fall about two inches into the tunnel. Carefully enlarge the opening to accommodate insertion of a teaspoon of ZP RODENT BAIT into each active tunnel. Cover the opening with soil. Take care not to cover bait with soil.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store in original container, in a dry acid-free container, and use.
