On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an indorsement or approval of this product by this Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. Enclosed is a copy of your label stamped "Accepted". This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Exposure to Warfarin during pregnancy should be avoided. Warfarin may cause harm to the fetus, including possible birth defects.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: If ingested, administer Vitamin K1 intramuscularly or orally, as indicated in bishydroxycoumarin overdoses. Repeat as necessary, based on monitoring of prothrombin times. Severe cases may require administering Vitamin K1 intravenously and giving blood transfusions.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

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3. Under "DIRECTIONS FOR USE", you may add "and in transport vehicles" after "man-made structures", as allowed on Pages 15-16 of the Warfarin Reregistration Eligibility Document (RED).
4. Modify the first paragraph of your "Container Disposal" as follows:

Completely empty bag into mixing equipment by shaking and taping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Then dispose ... same manner.

Your Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), dated June 10, 1992, is acceptable, and has been placed in our file for this product. All previous CSF's are obsolete.

Submit three (3) copies of the Analytical Method (62-3) used to identify the active ingredient. According to our February 26, 1981, letter, you had submitted an acceptable method. However, we were unable to locate the method in our files.

Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

Registrants may sell or distribute products bearing old labeling for **one year** after the date of this Notice. **Non-registrants** may sell or distribute products bearing old labeling for **three years** after the date of this Notice.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
