

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:  
HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC  
ANIMALS**

**CAUTION:** Keep away from humans, domestic animals and pets. Exposure during pregnancy should be avoided. If swallowed, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. When mixing baits, wear dust respirator and rubber gloves. If on skin, wash with soap and water.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** If ingested, administer Vitamin K<sub>1</sub> intramuscularly or orally, as indicated in bishydroxycoumarin overdoses. Repeat as necessary based on monitoring of prothrombin times.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD:**  
Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**MIXING DIRECTIONS**  
Thoroughly mix one part of Concentrate with 19 parts of a suitable bait material (e.g., grain, fish, meat, and vegetable).

Materials resembling human food must be altered in form by crushing, balling or pelleting so that they are not readily recognizable as food.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control of Norway rats, Roof rats and House mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. Treated baits must be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or wildlife or in tamper-proof bait boxes.

Place meat and fish baits only in tamper-proof bait boxes or deeply into rat burrows because dogs and cats will actively search them out.

Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:** Determine areas where rats and/or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been observed. Remove as much food as possible.

For formulation only into registered end-use rodenticides used in and around buildings and similar man-made structures, and in transport vehicles, and sites such as dumps, sewers, river and pond banks, feedlots, rabbitry fur farms, and game bird operations for the control of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice.

### APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

**RATS:** Apply 4 to 16 ounces of bait per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

**MICE:** Apply ¼ to ½ ounce (1-2 level table spoons) of bait at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 ounces) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

**RATS & MICE:** Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately.

If perishable baits (meat, fish, or vegetable) are used, place fresh baits in late afternoon. Replace daily with fresh baits.

Collect and dispose of all dead animals and unconsumed bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, eliminate food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store only in original container, in a dry area inaccessible to children and pets.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal or discharge of excess pesticide spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Do not discharge in lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit. For guidance, contact your regional office of the EPA.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.
