Non-urban areas: May be used inside of homes only.


For both areas treated baits must be placed in tamper-proof boxes or in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or wildlife. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

GENERAL USE CLASSIFICATION

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of Norway rats and mice in and around the periphery of homes and public buildings located in urban areas and in alleys located in urban areas. Do not use in parks. CONTRAC may also be used inside trains, aircraft and in and around related structures. Treated baits must be placed in locations inaccessible to pets, domestic animals, wildlife or in locations where they are not likely to be consumed. Don't place bait in areas where there's a possibility of food or surfaces that come in direct contact with rodents and/or mice.

Where a continuous infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations as needed.
