The proposed revised label submitted for this product on September 7, 1993, is basically acceptable, but two changes are needed. The signal word "CAUTION" should appear above "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" on the center panel and the text

"See right side panel for additional precautionary statements."

should appear below "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN."

Although the word "PELLETED," which appears on the current accepted label for this product, is missing from the proposed revised label, our understanding remains that the bait sold under this registration number is a pelleted bait. A separate registration would be needed for a meal bait of the same composition.

Submit five (5) copies of final printed labels, revised as indicated above, before this product is released for shipment under this labeling.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**READ THIS LABEL:** Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are filled, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Ever stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice in and around homes, industrial, commercial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product may also be used inside transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in related port or terminal buildings.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:** Determine areas where rats and mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

**MICE:** Apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (1-2 lbs.) Space placements are 12' apart. Be needed at points of entry and of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

**RATS AND MICE:** Replace and dispose of all dead animals and sources of rodent food, water, etc. does occur, repeat treatment. We establish permanent bait stations.
