
Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS Treated baits must be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals, wildlife or placed in larger grain bait stations. Do not place baits in areas where there is a possibility of direct contact with food.

For control of house mice in and around homes, industrial, commercial, agricultural, poultry, buildings, and similar structures. Quintox may also be used inside transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in and around related port or terminal landings.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS These mice areas where mice will most likely feed and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, in cramped openings, in or beneath burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls or in holes, holes, where rodents or their signs have been observed. Protect bait from tampering. Remove as much bait as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS
HOUSE MICE: Place 1 to 2 QUINTOX place packs of contents of 8 to 12 baits per place pack. Larger place packs (up to 3 place packs) may be needed at points of high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until all signs of mouse activity cease.

NOTE: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Contact and disposal of all bait stations and unaccounted bait properly. To prevent contamination, minimize bait spillage and harborage as much as possible. If reinfection does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and refresh bait as needed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Keep away from humans, domestic animals and pets.
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If swallowed, drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by inducing back of throat with finger. Avoid use of oil.
