DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are filled, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hooded livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS:

For control of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice in and around homes, industrial buildings, and similar man-made structures. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:

Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

RATS: Place 2 to 5 Place Pacs per place uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 14 days.
MICE: Open the pac and place 1/4 to 1/2 (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of very frequent activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait.

RATS/MICE: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait. Collect and dispose of all dead animals properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit access to water, and harborage as much as possible. If infestation occurs, repeat treatment. Where a continuous infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations as needed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Keep away from humans, domestic animals, and pets. If swallowed, this material may reduce the blood and cause bleeding.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: If ingested, administer milk or water, as indicated in hospital records. Repeat as necessary based on mortality.
