Notices 2001 and 2001-6 and to make other minor changes.

Label review The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide,
Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one
(1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship

your product.

1. Change "RATS AND MICE" to "FOLLOW-UP".

- 2. Under "CAUTION", add this 2nd Sentence: "Wear waterproof gloves when handling the bait."
- 3. Modify the "First Aid" section as indicated in Enclosure 1.
- 4. Modify the "MICE" text as follows:

MICE: Open pack and apply 1/4 to ½ oz. (1 to 2 level tablespoons) of bait at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days.

Existing stocks

Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.


