SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:
Rats or mice will most likely find and consume bait in these areas along walls, by gnawing burrows, in corners and concealed walls, or in locations where rodents or mice are active. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION:
Each bait block in this container weighs 1.5 lbs.

RATS: Place 3 to 16 All-Weather Di-Blox (15 to 30 feet) per placement. Maintain fresh bait for at least 10 days or until activity ceases.
HOUSE MICE: Apply 1 block per placement at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Repeat at points of very high mouse activity. If a disrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days is needed, activity ceases.
RATS AND MICE: Replace contaminated bait daily. Collect and dispose of all debris properly. To prevent reinfestation, eliminate water, and harborage as much as possible. If necessary, repeat treatment. Where a colony is present, establish permanent bait stations as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. **STORAGE:** Store only in original container, inaccessible to children and pets.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved disposal facility.
