DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS:

For control of Norway rats in sewers. Also for control of Norway rats and roof rats in the following areas:

URBAN AREAS:

May be used in and around the periphery of homes, industrial, commercial, and public buildings. CONTRAC SUPER SIZE BLOX may also be used in and around transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and related port or terminal buildings. May also be used in alleys and sewers.

NON-URBAN AREAS:

May be used inside of homes and agricultural buildings.

Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between doors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

RATS: Use one bait block per use wire to secure block at placements at appropriate intervals. Maintain an uninterrupted supply or until signs of rat activity cease.

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait and dispose of all dead animals to prevent reinfestation, limit sources of food as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, Where a continuous source of food is present, use permanent bait stations and
