**Purpose** This submission revises your label according to our last letter.

**Claims** We have the following comments about two claims on your proposed label: 1) all-weather and 2) sewers.

1. Weather-Resistant Claims

In our January 2, 1997, letter, we noted problems with the use of weather-resistant claims for this and related products because Bell had not submitted data on weathered product. To retain such claims and use of the product in wet or damp areas (including sewers), you need to submit the supporting data or remove these types of claims.

2. Sewers

Without data, we could not re-register this product with a sewer claim.

**Label** The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

1. Revise the last sentence under “**URBAN AREAS**” as follows: “May also be used in alleys and sewers.”
2. For non-homeowner sizes (>1 lb), use the following format for your “Storage and Disposal” text:

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Storage:** Store ...other chemical.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes ... disposal facility.

**Pesticide Container:** Do not ... proper disposal.

3. We prefer that you structure your “**USE RESTRICTIONS**” as follows to clarify the relationship between this heading and its two subheadings:

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control ... Do not broadcast bait.

**Urban Areas:** This product ... in alleys.

**Non-Urban Areas:** This product ... buildings.

4. After “For control of Norway rats and roof rats.” add this sentence:

Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

A copy of the stamped label is enclosed for your records.

**Existing stocks** Stocks of existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

**Consequence for non-compliance** If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**READ THIS LABEL:** Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets, or nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store unused product out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from bait stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hooved livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container and unused, spoiled, or unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control of Norway rats and roof rats. When used in USDA-inspected facilities, this product must be applied in tamper-resistant bait stations. Do not broadcast bait.

**URBAN AREAS:** This product may be used in and around the periphery of homes, industrial, commercial, and public buildings. May also be used in transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in and around related port or terminal buildings. May also be used in alleys.

**NON-URBAN AREAS:** This product may be used inside of homes and agricultural buildings.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:** Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain and snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:**

Apply 1 or 2 bait blocks per placement. One-8 oz. bait block may provide enough bait to kill two to eight rats. Use two blocks only at points of extremely high rat activity. Space placements at appropriate intervals - usually 15 to 30 feet apart.

For use in sewers, thread wire through block and securely attach to a stationary structure such as the bottom step of a manhole ladder or a sewer grate. Allow just enough wire for the block to rest on manhole benching. If benching is not present, suspend block a few inches above the high water mark or secure block on a board supported by opposing steps of the ladder. Securing block in this manner will prevent removal by rats or water. Use at

least 15 blocks per manhole. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**
