1. Directly below the name of the product on the front page, you state "*Norway rats and house mice may consume*..." However, the **USE RESTRICTIONS** only list Norway rats and roof rats. Please fix the front panel statement to say "*Norway rats and roof rats may consume*..."

2. Revise your "**FIRST AID**" and "**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN**" text as follows:

FIRST AID

HAVE LABEL WHEN OBTAINING TREATMENT ADVICE IF SWALLOWED:

- Call a poison control center, doctor, 1-877-854-2494, or 1-800-858-7378¹ [optional phone numbers] immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.

IF ON SKIN:

• Wash with plenty of soap and water.

IF IN EYES:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

USE RESTRICTIONS: "For control only of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice in the sites identified below for **Urban Areas** and **Non-urban Areas**. Do not place in edible product areas of feed processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food or feed is commercially prepared or processed or place near or inside ventilation duct openings. When this product is used in USDA-inspected facilities, all bait placements must be in tamper-resistant bait stations. Do not broadcast bait."

URBAN AREAS: "This product may only be used in and around homes, industrial, commercial, and public buildings; in transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in and around related port or terminal buildings; in alleys and in sewers. Do not apply further than 50 feet from buildings."

NON-URBAN AREAS: "This product may only be used inside of homes and agricultural buildings."

5. Under APPLICATION DIRECTIONS, add the following directions for sewer uses: "For sewer applications, run a wire through the holes in the bait blocks and attach the wire to a stationary structure such as the bottom step of a manhole ladder or to a sewer grate, allowing just enough wire for the blocks to rest on manhole benching. If benching is not present, suspend bait block a few inches above the high water line or place blocks on a board supported by opposing steps of the ladder. Securing blocks in this manner will minimize the chances for removal by rats or water. Place at least 12 bait blocks per manhole."

6. In the **SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS** section, revise "Determine areas where rats and mice will most likely find and consume the bait." to read "Determine areas where rats will most likely find and consume the bait."

7. Revise the second sentence of the second paragraph in the **APPLICATION DIRECTIONS** to read, "*Wearing gloves, collect and dispose...*"

8. Revise the text under "CAUTION" as follows:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Keep away from children, domestic animals and pets. Causes moderate eye irritation, do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. All handlers (including applicators) must wear: shoes plus socks, and gloves. Any person who retrieves carcasses or unused bait following application of this product must wear gloves.

User Safety Requirements

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash hands thoroughly after applying bait and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet and change into clean clothing.

9. Add the following sentence to the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS section: "Dogs and predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait."

10. Insert "Pesticide" before "Storage" in the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL section.

11. The following marketing claims are not allowed:

- a. Can be used alone or in Tomcat Bait Stations
- b. Ideal for use in Tomcat Bait Stations

12. Revise your **WARRANTY** statement, "Seller makes no warranty, expressed or implied..." to read "To the extent consistent with applicable law, seller makes..."

Stocks of product with existing labels may be used for twelve (12) months. As stated under the **Terms and Conditions of Sale and Distribution** on page 35 of the Agency's revised May 28, 2008 "*Risk Mitigation Decision for Ten Rodenticides*":

a. Product is prohibited for sale in stores oriented towards residential consumers: Grocery, Drug, Hardware and Home Improvement. It is acceptable for sale in stores oriented toward agricultural consumers: Farm, Agricultural, Tractor Stores.

b. Product may not be sold in packaging that holds less than 16 pounds of bait.

This product is in full compliance with the Agency's revised May 28, 2008 "Risk Mitigation Decision for Ten Rodenticides".

Note: Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ THIS LABEL**: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions. Use only for sites, pests and application methods described on the label.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

- 1. Store unused product out of reach of children and pets.
- 2. Bait stations are mandatory for outdoor, above ground use. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. Do not apply further than 50 feet from buildings. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. When used in USDA-inspected facilities, this product must be applied in tamper-resistant bait stations. Do not broadcast bait.

Do not sell in individual containers holding less than 16 pounds of bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain and snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Apply 1 or 2 bait blocks per placement. One-8 oz. bait block may provide enough bait to kill two to eight rats. Use two blocks only at points of extremely high rat activity. Space placements at appropriate intervals - usually 15 to 30 feet apart. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. <u>Collect</u> and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.
