READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait used to control pocket gophers and moles directly into their underground tunnels.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

POCKET GOPHERS AND MOLES

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may be used to control pocket gophers (*Thomomys* spp. and *Geomys* spp.) and moles (*Scalopus* spp. and *Scapanus* spp.) in rangeland, cropland, (grain fields, forage crops, hay and alfalfa crops, and vegetable crops). This product may also be used in forest areas, parks, nurseries, lawns, golf courses, around homes, and other noncrop areas. Bait must be applied directly into moles' or pocket gophers' underground burrow systems. Collect and bury all dead animals found above the ground.

DIRECTIONS FOR POCKET GOPHERS: Use one of the following baiting methods for controlling pocket gophers.

PLUG REMOVAL BAITING: Borowing pocket gophers (*Thomomys* spp. and *Geomys* spp.) throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the left side of the fan and are plugged with soil. With a long-handled spoon carefully remove the plug. Open 1 MOLE AND GOPHER BAIT packet and pour the contents into the tunnel as far down as possible. Reclose opening, being careful not to cover bait with soil.

MAIN RUNWAY BAITING: To locate main runways, probe about 6-8 inches away from mounds by use of an iron bar, a string stick, or other suitable implement. Resistance on probe will drop suddenly and probe will fall about two inches when main runway is entered. Carefully enlarge the opening to accommodate placement of the bait. Open 1 MOLE AND GOPHER BAIT packet and pour the contents into each active tunnel. Carefully close the hole with a stone, sod, or soil. Take care not to cover bait with soil.

DIRECTIONS FOR MOLES: The presence of moles may be indicated by a network of surface edges in the turf, by a series of conical mounds of earth pushed up from deep burrows, or by damage to bulbs.

SURFACE MOUNDS: Prior to treatment determine which tunnels are active according to one of the following two methods. (Either press down a one-inch section of the tunnel or remove a one inch section of the tunnel's roof. Mark this section; and recheck in 24 hours. The burrow is considered active if the baited tunnel has been raised up or if the roof has been repaired. Only treat active burrows. Carefully punch a hole in the top of active tunnels. Open 1 MOLE AND GOPHER BAIT packet and pour the contents into the tunnel. Carefully close the hole with sod or stone. Do not collapse the runway again or allow loose soil to cover the bait. After a few days check to see if the burrows are still active according to one of the two methods described above. If so, repeat treatment.

CONICAL MOUNDS: Remove center plug from the conical mounds with aid of a long-handled spoon. Then open and pour the contents of 1 MOLE AND GOPHER BAIT packet into the underground tunnel. Close opening with rock or sod. Do not allow loose dirt to cover bait.

BULB PROTECTION: (Fall planted): Pack about one-quarter inch of soil against each bulb. Open 1 MOLE AND GOPHER BAIT packet and sprinkle several baits at edges of and around the bulb. One packet will protect 7 to 10 bulbs. Then cover.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry acid-free place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

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
