- 2. On your proposed labeling submitted August 27, 1997 make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment.
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 12455-88.
 - b. The "STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT" on your proposed label must be amended to read exactly as follows:

"If Swallowed: Call physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention. If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention. If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists."

- c. The "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN" section that appears on the left panel of your proposed label should be moved to a position just below the last Statement of Practical Treatment (on the front panel, if it fits, or at the top of the left panel), but should be clearly distinguished from the Statements of Practical Treatment. - j. Under STORAGE AND DISPOSAL," amend the "STORAGE" statement to read:

"STORAGE: Store in a locked storage area in a dry place. Store only in original container. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near food or feed."

- 3. Submit two copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
- 4. A copy of our review of the product chemistry data submitted for Technical Brodifacoum was attached to our letter dated March 4, 1997. The product chemistry review indicated that your technical contains fewer impurities than Zeneca's Brodifacoum Technical, therefore the two technical products are not considered chemically similar. However, a subsequent toxicology review indicated that the two technical products are considered toxicologically similar and that, with the exception of the product chemistry data discussed below, no additional data would be required for Bell's Technical Brodifacoum at this time (based on Bell's citation of existing generic data).

The product chemistry review for Technical Brodifacoum listed stability data (63-13) and vapor pressure (63-9) as data gaps. You have submitted a stability

study (MRID 442403-01) which is currently in review. Please note that the registration of this product is conditional upon the conclusions of our review of the stability study. The requirement for vapor pressure data is still outstanding. Within 30 days of receipt of this letter you must indicate, in writing, how you intend to address this data gap (i.e. commit to conduct a vapor pressure study, cite appropriate published literature, etc.).

If the above specified conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.


