



b. Revise "Norway rats and house mice may consume..." located above the ingredients statement, to read "Norway rats, roof rats and house mice may consume..." on Pages 1 and 4.

c. Revise your "FIRST AID" and "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN" text as follows:

FIRST AID

HAVE LABEL WHEN OBTAINING TREATMENT ADVICE

IF SWALLOWED:

- Call a poison control center, doctor, 1-877-854-2494, or 1-800-858-7378¹ immediately for treatment advice.
- Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.

IF ON SKIN:

- Wash with plenty of soap and water.

TREATMENT FOR PET POISONING

If animal eats bait, call veterinarian or 1-800-xxx-xxxx [optional] at once.

NOTE TO VETERINARIAN

Anticoagulant Bromadiolone: For animals ingesting bait and/or showing poisoning signs (bleeding or elevated prothrombin times), give Vitamin K₁ at [insert does if known]. If needed, check prothrombin times every 3 days until values return to normal (up to 30 days). In severe cases, blood transfusions may be needed.

d. As stated in 40CFR156.140(a)(4), a batch code must be included on the label or package for container and containment for nonrefillables.

e. In the **USE RESTRICTIONS** section on Pages 2 and 5, revise "Do not use in homes or human residences" to read "Do not use in homes or other human residences."

f. In the **USE RESTRICTIONS** section on Pages 2 and 5, include "Do not use in edible product areas of food or feed processing plants or other areas where food or feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not contaminate food/feed or food/feed handling equipment or place near or inside ventilation duct openings." after the sentence that ends with "...direct contact with food."

g. Under **APPLICATION DIRECTIONS** on Pages 2 and 5, insert **HOUSE** before **MICE**.

h. Revise the text under "**CAUTION**" as follows:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Keep away from children, domestic animals and pets. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

All handlers (including applicators) must wear shoes plus socks, and gloves. Any person who retrieves carcasses or unused bait following application of this product must wear gloves.

User Safety Requirements

Follow manufacturer's instruction for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash hands thoroughly after applying bait and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet and change into clean clothing.

i. Revise the second sentence of the **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** section on pages 3 and 6 to read as follows: *"Dogs and other predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait."*

j. Insert **"Pesticide"** before **"Storage"** in the **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** section on Pages 3 and 6.

k. Make the same changes to the **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN** section on Page 4 that were listed on Page 1.

l. The following marketing claims are not allowed:
- Easy to use

3. Storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) data must be submitted within 18 months.

4. As stated under the **Terms and Conditions of Sale and Distribution** on page 35 of the Agency's revised May 28, 2008 *"Risk Mitigation Decision for Ten Rodenticides"*:

a. Product is prohibited for sale in stores oriented towards residential consumers: Grocery, Drug, Hardware and Home Improvement. It is acceptable for sale in stores oriented toward agricultural consumers: Farm, Agricultural, Tractor Stores.

b. Product may not be sold in packaging that holds less than 8 pounds of bait.

5. This product is in full compliance with the Agency's revised May 28, 2008 *"Risk Mitigation Decision for Ten Rodenticides"*.

6. **Note:** Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, **regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website**

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may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

7. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions. Use only for sites, pests, and application methods described on this label.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store unused product out of reach of children and pets.
2. Bait stations are mandatory for outdoor, above ground use. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from bait stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hooved livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container and unused, spoiled, or unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice. For use in and around agricultural buildings only. Do not apply further than 50 feet from agricultural buildings. Do not use in homes or human residences. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait. When used in USDA-inspected facilities, this product must be applied in tamper-resistant bait stations.

Do not sell this product in individual containers holding less than 8 pounds of bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain and snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

RATS: Apply 4 to 16 ounces of bait (usually at intervals of 15 to 30 feet) per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

MICE: Apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (1 - 2 level tablespoons) of bait per placement at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

FOLLOW-UP: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Using gloves, collect and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

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HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
