The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

1. Make the following label changes:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 12455-134"
 - b. Per the Agency's Acute Toxicity review, you must re-order the 'First Aid' statements as follows:

"If on skin . . .
If swallowed . . .
If in eyes . . ."

Also, add the following statement to the end of the 'First Aid' statement: "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-xxx-xxxx for emergency medical treatment information."
 - c. Revise the 'Directions for Use' statement to clarify that formulation for indoor and outdoor residential use products can only include non-food uses.
 - d. Place the 'Storage and Disposal' statement in a text box for prominence.
2. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit data.
3. Within sixteen (16) months of the date on this Notice of Registration, provide to the Agency acceptable data packages for Guideline Studies as follows:
 - a. OPPTS 830.6317, (Storage Stability) and OPPTS 830.6320 (Corrosion Characteristics).
 - b. OPPTS 830.1800, Enforcement Analytical Method. A study must be re-submitted that includes the chromatographic analytical conditions and method validation, with a batch by batch analysis as determined in the preliminary analysis. See additional requirements in the attached Agency Product Chemistry Review.
 - c. OPPTS 870.8700, Immunotoxicity. The study submitted was not applicable as the Agency's Health Effects Division does not review data from cattle for fulfillment of this data requirement. You must submit or cite an acceptable study in accordance with the published Agency Guidelines.

If acceptable data is not submitted within 16 months of this NOR, this registration will expire on February 13, 2013.

Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
