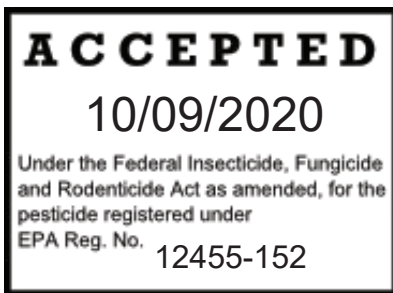

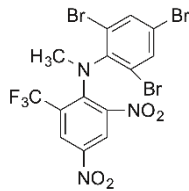

[Image of Bromethalin Structure]

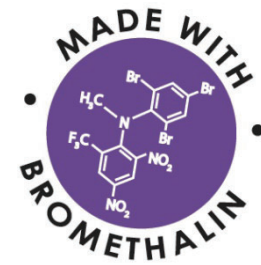
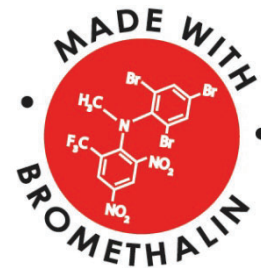
