### DIRECTIONS

WINTER ALGAECIDE is a maintenance product specifically designed to prevent the growth of algae during the swimming pool shutdown. Keeps swimming pool water clear — Non-corrosive to lining. Controls algae slime during off season use. Helps reduce clean up time when pool is put in operation. Add a rate of 1 gallon for every 36,000 gallons of pool water, or 1 quart for every 9,000 gallons, before filter shutdown at end of swimming season and allow to circulate. (This treatment is usually sufficient for the normal off-season period. In some cases an additional one or two treatments may be necessary). Treatment should be repeated as above, but with no filter agitation, approximately four to six weeks before resuming daily pool operation.
