

USE DIRECTIONS:

Use at 1 ounce per gallon of water. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10 at this level.

At 1 ounce per gallon of water, this product is fungicidal against esthogenic fungi.

For best results, use Aqua Maid with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces. If used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment or other food contact items, limit the level of active quaternary to 200 from (1.4 oz. per 5 gallons).

NO RINSE REQUIRED.

For heavy soil or organic matter, a precleaning step is recommended.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.

Aqua Maid is a concentrated non-phosphate detergent, disinfectant, sanitizer, fungicide and deoderizer. It is specifically designed for Institutional use such as Hospitals, Nursing Homes, and Schools, where house-keeping will be of prime importance in controlling the hazard of cross-infection from environmental surfaces.

Aqua Maid is for use on floors, walls and other hard surfaces in Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Hotels, Public Area, Industrial Areas and in Institutions.

It is excellent for Operating Rooms, Rest Rooms, Nurseries and Food Service Areas.

When used as directed, Aqua Maid is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesius* and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*. Aqua Maid is also effective against pathogenic fungi, *Trichophyton interdigitale*.

If used for sanitization of previously cleaned food processing equipment or food contact items, limit the active quaternary to 200 ppm. At this level, No Potable Water Rinse is required.

This product when used on environmental, inanimate, hard surfaces at 1 ounce per gallon of water, is effective against Influenza A², Herpes Simplex, Adenovirus type 2, and Vaccinia and Viruses.

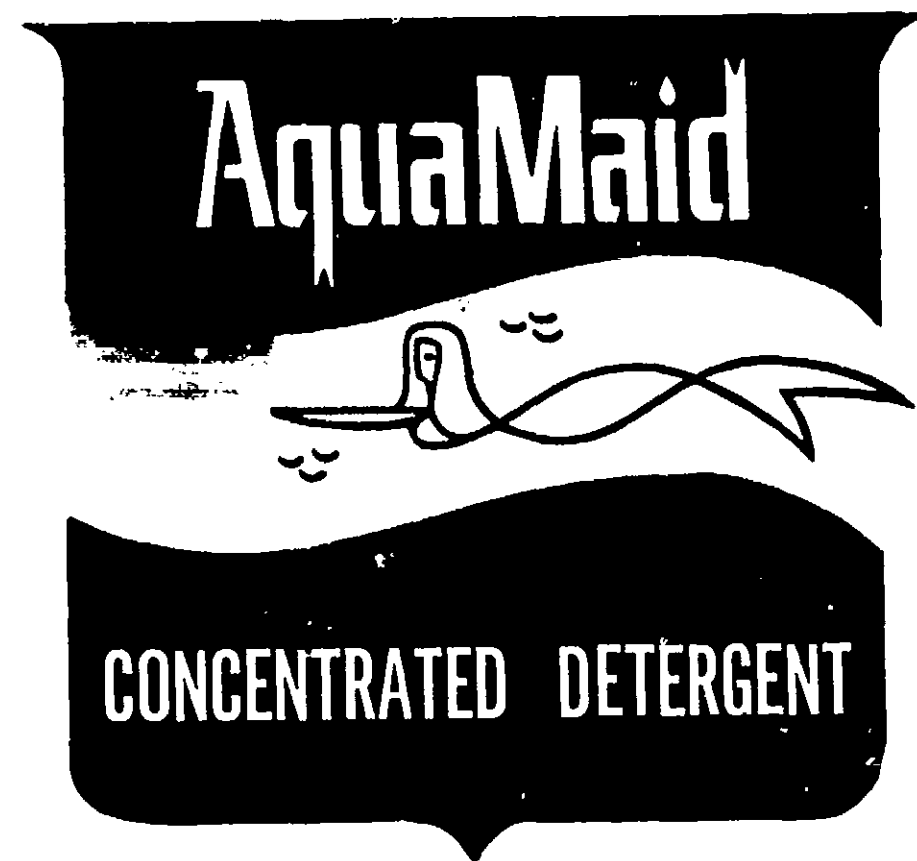
