WINTERIZING

Slow-Tabs are excellent for winter use in maintaining water clarity and killing most bacteria under a winter cover. Add slow-tabs to a floating chlorine dispenser - according to the directions on dispenser. Do not permit tablets to come in direct contact with vinyl liner.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is a disinfectant for swimming pool water against bacteria. Place tablets in a plastic skimmer basket or in a floating dispensor. Avoid metal objects.

Before using slow dissolve chlorine tablets for the first time — pool water should be stabilized. (See directions on Stabilizer container).

It is important to establish and maintain a pH reading of 7.2 to 7.6 using a suitable test kit.

With a shock dose of concentrated pool chlorine, treat the pool at a rate of 2 oz. per 1,000 gallons of pool water. After several hours, check the chlorine residual with a reliable text kit to determine whether a chlorine residual of 1.0 to 2.0 ppm has been attained. If the chlorine residual is less than this, repeat the shock dose.

Slow dissolve chlorine tablets should be added daily or as needed at the rate of 2½ oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water to maintain an effective chlorine level of 1.5 ppm.

Test pool water frequently to maintain proper pH and chlorine levels.

During heavy bathing loads, it may become necessary to repeat the shock dose. Swimmers should not be allowed back into the pool until the chlorine residual has dropped to a level of 1.0 to 2.0 ppm.
