

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE** AQUA MAID CHLORINE TABLETS FAST DISSOLVE help prevent the growth of algae in swimming pools. Place tablet in plastic dissolving basket or pool skimmer. Avoid metal objects.

Before using AQUA MAID CHLORINE TABLETS FAST DISSOLVE for the first time, pool water should be stabilized with AQUA MAID STABILIZER at the rate of 4 lbs. per every 10,000 gallons of pool water. Stabilizer increases the effective life of chlorine by minimizing loss due to the sun. Add the Stabilizer slowly to the pool skimmer. Do not backwash filter for two days after this application.

With a shock dose of AQUA MAID CONCENTRATED POOL CHLORINE treat the pool at a rate of 2 oz. per 1,000 gallons of pool water. After several hours, check the chlorine residual with a reliable test kit. Level must be between 1.0 PPM and 2.0 PPM. If the level is less than this, repeat shock treatment.

Place 3 oz. of tablets in the pool skimmer or dissolving basket to provide daily chlorination of 1.5 PPM for each 10,000 gallons of pool water. Add more tablets if necessary to maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 PPM to 2.0 PPM.

Test pool water frequently with a suitable chlorine test kit to maintain your chlorine residual.

During heavy bathing loads, it may become necessary to super-chlorinate or shock the pool with AQUA MAID CONCENTRATED POOL CHLORINE at the rate of 2 oz. per 1,000 gallons of pool water. Swimmers should not be permitted in the pool until the chlorine residual has reached a level of 1.0 to 1.5 PPM.

Chlorine is most effective in water having a pH level of 7.2 to 7.8 PPM. Adjust accordingly using either AQUA MAID pH INCREASE or DECREASE.

## DANGER

Round Pools: Diameter X Diameter X Average Depth (in feet) X 5.9 gives pool capacity in gallons.
