DANGER Highly Irritant. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product may be toxic to fish and other aquatic life. Do not discharge into streams, ponds, or other bodies of water. Dispose of waste in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations. See EPA Form 400 for more information.

**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS
STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT**

Reacts with water to form a strong oxidizing agent. Do not add this product to water. Do not mix with other chemicals. May cause fire or explosion. Do not use in confined spaces. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not use in areas where there is a fire hazard. Do not use in areas where there is a risk of explosion.

FIRST AID

If swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Drink water or milk. If symptoms persist, seek medical attention.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical attention.

If on skin: Wash with soap and water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store in areas where there is a fire hazard. Do not store in areas where there is a risk of explosion. Do not store in areas where there is a risk of contamination. Dispose of waste in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations. See EPA Form 400 for more information.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not handle this product with bare hands. Use gloves or thoroughly clean your hands.

START UP

Before using tablets for the first time, pool water should be stabilized. Follow directions on Clorox Stabilizer label. Adjust and maintain the pH in the range of 7.2-7.8 using pH increase or pH Decrease as indicated by a reliable test kit. Adjust and maintain total alkalinity at 80-100 ppm based on test results and label directions on Total Alkalinity Control. With a shock dose of 2 oz. per 1,000 gallons, use a chlorinated swimming chemical such as Shock Treatment to establish a free chlorine residual of 1.0-1.5 ppm. Repeat this step if necessary until residuals maintained.

DAILY

Each tablet weighs 7 ounces. Suggested dosage is one tablet per 25,000 gallons.

These tablets may be used in various types of feeding devices such as a floating dispenser or automatic chlorinator. Adjust feeding device according to manufacturer's directions to assure constant treatment level of 1.0-1.5 ppm of free chlorine residual determined by a reliable test kit. Discharge rate of feeding device may vary due to unusual conditions such as high temperature, heavy bath load, flow rate per tap, wind and rain. Therefore frequent use of test kit is recommended. Do not add tablets directly to pool or spa. Use other methods. Avoid metal objects.

SHOCK TREATMENT


It may be necessary to repeat shock dosage with a weekly dose if algae appears, eye burn or irritation occurs. Use tablets with bath load or high temperature. Shock dose of 2 oz. per 1,000 gallons indicates presence of combined chlorine. Shock dose of 2 oz. per 1,000 gallons frequently to maintain proper free chlorine level and free chlorine residual. If shock dose is used, use a water conditioner to restore residual and dropped below 2 ppm.

WINTERIZING

These tablets are not meant for winter use. Maintaining water clarity and keeping residual level up over a winter season. Add tablets to a dispenser or floating dispenser. Use floating dispenser if on ice. Do not use tablets in a winter season.

DANGER
