

**DIRECTION FOR USE**  
**General Classification**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When used as directed, it will kill and prevent development of chlorella pyrenoidosa (green), phormidium inunctatum (black algae), Phormidium retzii (Square D algae), Lyngba versicolor (blue-green), and other swimming pool algae.

**INITIAL APPLICATION:** To a cleaned pool add one quart to 50,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** Use 1/2 quart to 50,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. Use this dosage immediately after heavy rain. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

**WINTER USE:** Add to a cleaned pool at the rate of one quart to 50,000 gallons of water before filter shut down at end of swimming season. Allow to circulate. Cover the pool after application. Repeat treatment above with no filter agitation 4 to 6 weeks before resuming daily pool operation.

**DANGER**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes or on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulation shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your regional office of the EPA.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or premixed with other water-treating chemicals. Works best when added by itself directly to pool water. Use dilution is non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces.
