

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a product of Federal law for sale in this country in a manner restricted to winterizing. This product is a dry chlorine which is highly effective as a winterizing agent. It is a more effective agent than other dry chlorine products because of its stability with additional side forming minerals to allow water.

FOR WINTER USE

Before winterizing, your pool should be cleaned the day before you begin. Run filter for 24 hours. Add 1 lb. of Aquam for every 10,000 gal. of pool water. Add Winterizing product to the pool water. Add Winterizing product to the pool water. Add Winterizing product to the pool water.
