HOW TO USE:

Shake Before Using

Spray infested surfaces.

To Control: Ants

Boxelder Bug

Centipedes

Cockroaches

Crickets

Earwigs

Spray areas where these insects hide, including dark corners, cracks, crevices, along baseboards and frames, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets and plumbing and other utility areas. Flush out of hiding spots.

Ants: Treat ant trails, nests. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Lice: Spray in an inconspicuous area to avoid possible staining or discoloration. After drying, then proceed with laundering. Spray only those garments, including mattresses, and bedding that will be either laundered or dried.

To Control Brown Dog Ticks: Spray sleeping quarters of animals. Spray areas around baseboards, window frames, wall and floor coverings. Areas of infestation occur and treatment should be repeated as necessary. Do not place in animal quarters. Do Not Treat Animals With This Pesticide.

To Control: Carpet Beetle, Cigarette Beetle, Clothes Moth

Spray edges of carpeting, rugs and closets. Make holes in the floor and baseboards, cracks, crevices, closets and shelving and/or wherever insects are suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Control: Fruit Flies
Gnats
House Flies
Mosquitos
Small Flying Moths

For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures or porches, in garages and other places where these insects might congregate.

To Control Fleas Indoors:

Thoroughly apply as a spray for spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet area. Do Not Treat Pets With This Product. To control the source of the flea infestation, pets inhabiting the treated premises should be treated with a product registered for application to animals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
