START UP

QUICK TABS for the first time pool water should be used as a **CONDITIONER AND STABILIZER**. Follow the label. Add one tablet per 10,000 gallons of water. **INCREASE OR DECREASE** as indicated on the label. Add one tablet per 10,000 gallons of water. **TOTAL ALKALINITY CONTROL** - Add one tablet per 10,000 gallons of water. **SHOCK TREATMENT** - Add one tablet per 10,000 gallons of water. Repeat the shock treatment if necessary. Add one tablet per 10,000 gallons of water.

DAILY

QUICK TABS 1 tablet per 10,000 gallons of water. Add one tablet per 10,000 gallons of water. Repeat the shock treatment if necessary. Add one tablet per 10,000 gallons of water.

Shock treatment is required to kill algae and bacteria. Add one tablet per 10,000 gallons of water. Repeat the shock treatment if necessary. Add one tablet per 10,000 gallons of water.
