



INTERNAL: If swallowed, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. Call a physician IMMEDIATELY!

EXTERNAL: If on skin, in case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water.

PHYSICIAN'S NOTE

This compound contains Endrin and Methyl Parathion.

Methyl Parathion exerts muscarinic-like effects—i.e., stimulation of the para-sympathetic nervous system. Repeated use of a para-sympathetic depressant, such as atropine to the limit of patient's tolerance, is indicated to relieve symptoms. The administration of oxygen is helpful. Never give morphine to patients suspected of Methyl Parathion poisoning.

2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Endrin produces central nervous system excitation which ordinarily responds to barbituric acid derivatives, but this drug should be administered only if complete atropinization fails to relieve symptoms.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Mix this formulation with water by agitation or by circulating the mixture through the spray pump and back into the tank. A proper mixture will have the appearance of a milky emulsion with no free oil on the surface. Agitate before use until a uniform emulsion is formed. For best control with ground equipment, apply recommended amount of insecticide in 3 to 5 gallons of water per acre. Apollo 1.6-1.6 can be used with conventional low volume, low pressure ground equipment, with hand sprayers or by airplane.

Crop	In Control	Remarks
Cotton	Fleahoppers, Thrips	Early season use—Apply 1 to 2 pints per acre in sufficient water to give uniform coverage. Apply when insects first appear and repeat as necessary.
Cotton	Aphids, Bollworm, Boll Weevil, Cabbage Looper, Cotton Leafworms, Cutworms, Ear Armyworms, Fleahoppers, Grasshoppers, Rapid Plant Bug, Tarnished Plant Bug, Thrips, Mites (certain species)	Mid and late season use—1 to 2 pints in sufficient water to give uniform coverage. Repeat at 3 to 5 day intervals until infestation is under control. Thorough coverage is necessary for best results.

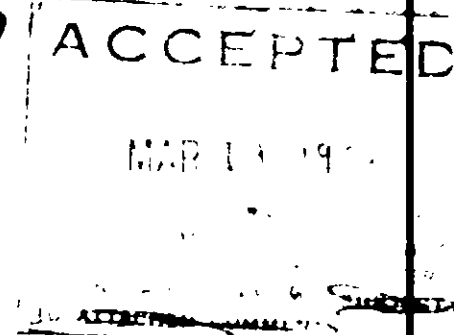

DANGER

Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Repeated irritation or skin contact may without symptoms progressively increase susceptibility to Methyl Parathion poisoning. Vacated areas should not be reentered until drifting insecticide and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs.
