

CLEANING-Lightly Soiled areas - surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 1/2 ounces of Pine Oil per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

DISINFECT-walls, floors and other hard surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants and rest-rooms mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1 1/2 ounces of Pine Oil per gallon of water.

Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 2 ounces of Pine Oil per gallon of water and then disinfected. Those surfaces which may later come in contact with food must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

SANITIZATION-walls, floors and equipment first clean thoroughly with a solution containing 1 1/2 ounces of Pine Oil per gallon of water. If surface is heavily soiled, use Pine Oil at a rate of 2 ounces per gallon to insure thorough cleaning.

DEODORIZATION

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning, mop or brush surfaces with a solution containing 2 ounces of PINE OIL per gallon of water. PINE OIL is an effective disinfectant cleaner designed for use in household, schools and public restrooms. When used as directed PINE OIL will disinfect hard surfaces, such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas and garbage pails where obnoxious odors may develop. This product may be used as a disinfectant in homes, schools, restaurants and public rest rooms where efficient cleaning and disinfectant action is desired.

DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Causes severe eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID
